#### **TOWN BOARD SETS GOALS FOR 2019**

The Town Board set the following goals at a workshop preceding the February 26 meeting. These goals will drive much of the work of the Board and Town employees for 2019.

- 1. Annexation of the Consaul property. Move the annexation process forward, including completion of the required comprehensive plan by June 1, 2019.
- 2. Continue infrastructure upgrades. Replacement of primary and secondary electrical lines in residential areas, paving of designated streets, and installation of residential and commercial water meters.
- 3. Park improvements. Resurface the baseball field in Community Park and purchase new equipment for Central Park.
- 4. Human Resources training for the entire Town staff.
- 5. Enforce dog ownership requirements.
- 6. Eliminate blight from the town, removing unsightly junk and trash to improve the overall appearance of Center.
- 7. Continue to explore downtown improvements.

## HAVE SHUTTLE, WILL TRAVEL

Looking for transportation to get to Alamosa or Salida for a doctor's appointment, shopping, or just to get out of town? The Eagle Line Shuttle can take you there.



The Shuttle picks up and delivers passengers each Tuesday and Wednesday at DJ's Café at Highway 112 and Broadway. On Tuesday, the Shuttle leaves Center at 8:49 am and stops at Saguache and Villa Grove on the way to Salida. It returns at 3:29 pm.

On Wednesday, it leaves Center at 9:03 am and travels through Del Norte and Monte Vista on the way to Alamosa. It returns to Center at 3:17 pm.

Prices are reasonable, ranging between \$1.00 and \$4.00, depending on the distance. For more information, call 719-530-8980 or check their pamphlet at the Town Hall or some Center businesses.
