




It is VERY IMPORTANT to fill in and return your Census form because the count of our population determines how many representatives we will have in state and federal government and how much money our town and county will receive from the government *for the next 10 years*. If you have not completed the Census, please do so in one of the following ways:

- 1. Go online to www.my2020census.gov.
- 2. Call 844-468-2020.
- 3. Fill out the paper form that will come in the mail or be delivered to your home by a census taker.

The questions asked by the Census are very simple, not personal in nature, and only take a few minutes. The information is confidential and does **not** include questions about legal status or finances. The Census is taken strictly to know how many people we have in our country. EVERYONE MUST BE COUNTED!



■ SALES TAX INCREASE PASSES

Center residents voted to pass the 2% sales tax increase at the April 7 municipal election by a vote of 166 for and 143 against. The increase will take effect July 1.

Watering days are as follows: for even numbered houses, watering days are Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday. For odd numbered houses, watering days are Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday. No watering is allowed on Monday.

Times for watering are 6:00 am to 10:00 am and 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm.
