

VETERANS' WALL PROJECT TO MOVE AHEAD

Watch for progress on completion of the Veterans' Wall at Casa Blanca Park. We will soon see granite etched with military symbols being mounted, and eventually the names of Center's veterans will be displayed.



In the meantime, we ask all citizens who have signed up their family members to be included on the wall to stop by Town Hall to check that the spelling of his/her name is correct. About 60 names will appear on the wall, but we think there are more veterans who have served from Center.

It is not too late to add names! If you know of a veteran, living or deceased, you would like to add to the wall, please bring his/her DD 214 to Town Hall and get that name added. There will be no charge for this.

ASSET INVENTORY? WHAT IS THAT?



Center has received funding to conduct an asset inventory of all property belonging to the Town, including an assessment of the condition and age of the property and a projection of how long it will last until it needs to be replaced. Roads, sidewalks, parks, town lots, buildings, natural gas, water and electrical systems will be evaluated by actual field inspection. Using satellite photographs, maps will be created, block-by-block, identifying our assets.

Reviews and tests of the assets will determine where improvements are needed, and a future replacement schedule will be recommended. With this information, we will be able to plan ahead and set aside the funds needed to maintain the Town of Center in good condition for our children and grandchildren.

The asset inventory will be performed by RG and Associates, an engineering firm with offices in Wheatridge, Del Norte, and Silverthorne, Colorado. They have served many communities in the Valley and throughout Colorado.
