9:30: Poker Run. \$10 per driver or passenger. \$5 for additional hand. Start at Casa Blanca Park.







We are pleased that the field is again available for use by the community.






NEW PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT CONSIDERED

DENTAL CLINIC FUNDED

The dental clinic planned for the previous Kingdom Hall location at 135 6th Street is moving closer to reality. A \$600,000 grant was received for the renovation by Valley Wide Health Services.

The Town of Center is the pass-through agency for this grant. Center's partnership with Valley Wide will lead to the new dental clinic with expanded services.

CENTER'S STREET PAVING ON HOLD TILL NEXT YEAR

The water meter project was slated to be underway by now, but due to a delay in funding, it won't be started until mid July. The project requires that our streets be cut for installation of the meters.

Soooo, street paving will be put off until next year to avoid cutting into brand new streets. We'll look forward to new streets in 2020.
