ATTENTION !!! ATTENTION !!!

Citizens of Center!!! We are in a serious drought! We have received only 2 inches of rain in all of 2018!

We MUST conserve water. Yet Center is using 1.3 million gallons of water per DAY. One overnight check found that twenty-six residents were watering ALL NIGHT LONG!

The abuse of our community water restrictions MUST stop. Therefore, no more warnings will be given. Tickets will be issued for all watering violations.

Please, citizens, abide by the rules: Even numbered houses may water from 6 am to 10 am and from 6 pm to 9 pm on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays. Odd numbered houses may water from 6 am to 10 am and from 6 pm to 9 pm on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. No watering on Mondays and no open hoses.

NEW ELECTRIC CONTRACT WILL SAVE MONEY

The Town has signed a contract for the purchase of electric power with Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska (M.E.A.N.), a branch of Nebraska Municipal Power Pool, of which we have been a member for many years. M.E.A.N. is a wholesale provider of power to 67 communities throughout the Midwest. This contract will provide many benefits such as energy audits, rate studies, and training opportunities. The best part is a lower rate for electricity, saving us approximately \$135,000 annually.



This contract will replace the contract with Excel for electricity, though transmission of power will continue with Excel.

CENTER HIRES NEW CHIEF OF POLICE

The Town Board voted unanimously to hire Tristan Van Zalinge to serve as our new Police Chief. He will begin work on August 6.

Officer Van Zalinge worked in Center several years ago, before moving on to other law enforcement positions In the Valley. He has lived in the Valley for 22 years and has a wife and three sons. We welcome Officer Van Zalinge to Center and look forward to working with him.

TOWN WORKING TO IMPROVE FISCAL SYSTEM

Town administration is working with DOLA – the Department of Local Affairs – to address some longstanding fiscal issues identified in our audits. Center is the first community in our region to participate in DOLA's Fiscal Stability Initiative. This program will help us to develop a capital improvement policy, a reserve policy, a budget policy, and an asset inventory.

These are big words but the bottom line is that this work will make our fiscal system more stable, with direction for future financial planning. We are proud to be involved in this initiative, and DOLA commends Center for the progress we are making.
