# DOWNTOWN COLORADO FUN: COME ONE, COME ALL!

With the goal of recharging Center's main street and sparking some possible new business enterprises, our Downtown Colorado effort is presenting three projects. We hereby urge Center citizens to participate in all three.

- 1. **The Business Development Training workshop:** To be held on October 4 from 7:00 to 10:00 pm at the Center Viking Youth Club at 386 Broadway for anyone ages 14 through 35. This FREE! workshop, valued at \$500, will be presented by Tom Monaco of the SLV-SBDC Small Business Development Center. It will lead participants in developing a business plan, setting financial goals, and pitching their idea. These plans will be entered in the Town's business plan competition. The top three winners will win a cash prize of \$500, \$300, or \$200 chosen at the Lights on Center event October 15. ## **WATER METER INSTALLATION UNDERWAY!**

Water meters are now being installed throughout Center. Installation will begin on Miles Street and move westward. Sisneros and Torrez Streets will be done after harvest is finished. You will receive a notice on your door when the installers will be coming to your home. On installation day, the water will be shut off from 8:00 am to approximately 3:00 pm.

Please plan ahead by storing the water you need in bottles, buckets, or bathtubs. When the installers are finished, open your outside hoses for about 5 minutes to flush the pipes out. In addition, run your faucets for several minutes before drinking. If you experience low water flow, clean the screens to your faucets, showers, or washing machines.


**IMPORTANT**: Also please move your vehicles from the front of your house on the day when your meter is being installed.

## TOWN SIGNS WITH NEW ELECTRICITY PROVIDER


The Town Board voted unanimously to sign a contract with MEAN (Municipal Energy Agency of Nebraska) to provide our electricity starting April of 2020. This ends the contract with Excel.

MEAN is a non-profit wholesale electricity supply organization that provides costbased power supply, transmission, and related services to 69 participating communities in four states, Colorado, Iowa, Nebraska, and Wyoming.

The Town Board expects better service and comparable, if not better prices, from MEAN.
