SNOW REMOVAL PLAN REVIEWED



Center's Snow Removal Plan is to organize safe travel routes for residents during snowstorms. The primary streets to be cleaned are Worth Street and the business district on 3rd and 4th Streets. Broadway and routes to the school are next. Residential areas follow, providing the primary streets are cleaned. The Town is responsible for streets only. Residents are responsible for sidewalks and right of ways in front of their property.

With recent snows and questions from Center residents, the Town Board is reviewing the Snow Removal Plan to make sure it meets our needs for safety and convenience. In addition to the needs of our

citizens, we also consider our budget, our manpower and equipment, and the amount and condition of the snow, whether it is light and fluffy or wet and

heavy.

The Town Board discussed the plan at a workshop on January 26 and agreed that some changes will be made. Ideas discussed were more sanding at intersections and shady spots on the streets; plowing of streets will be required for snowfalls of one inch or more; calling out of the crew will be at 4:30 am; and prohibiting parking on Worth Street from 2:00 am to 6:00 am.

These ideas will be further discussed and finalized at the February 9th Town Board meeting. If you have concerns or suggestions, please let Town Board members or employees know or attend the February 9 meeting. Thank you for your cooperation.

Coffee With the Chief will be held on February 6, 2021 at 9 am at the Methodist Church basement. All are welcome.


CHRISTMAS DECORATION WINNERS ANNOUNCED
