- o Launch an educational campaign to build public support for affordable housing and address common concerns.
- o Ensure all materials and sessions are accessible in both English and Spanish.

- o Actively shape and promote opportunities for local citizens to be involved in the project as contributors and subcontractors.
- o Identify and help develop local talent to assist with translation, facilitation, outreach, or other project-related tasks.
